- Learning to recognise numerals 1-10
- Counting up to 20 and understanding how to count accurately.
- Patterns in colours ,shapes ,objects sounds and actions
- Days of the week and language related to time.
- Introducing addition and subtraction.
- Learning to estimate.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Learning to talk to other people about what I want and need.
- Learning to play co-operatively.
- Learning to listen to others and find ways to resolve conflicts.
- Learning to talk about what I am good at.
