Recognise and order numbers to 20  
Know what is one more and one less up to 20  
Count in 2's up to 20  
Recognise and complete a repeating pattern  
Begin to double numbers up to 5  
Read simple number sentences using +/- and =  
Identify properties of 3D shapes  
Measurement - weight and height

### Literacy:

Review set 1 sounds and begin set 2 sounds  
Read and understand simple sentences  
Use phonic knowledge to decode regular words  
Read tricky words  
Use phonic knowledge to write regular and irregular words  
Begin to write simple sentences

### Physical development:

Handling tools effectively including pencils for writing  
Getting dressed and undressed independently.  
Going to the toilet independently

### Communication and Language:

Listening to stories, anticipating key events and asking questions  
Following instructions  
Using the past, present and future tense accurately when talking
