Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy New Year! Below are the details of our curriculum over the next term and ways in which you can support your child through year 3.

Homework and Reading

Homework will be set every week on Thursday and is due in on the following Thursday, this will usually be one piece of English and one maths but may occasionally change.

Reading at home is extremely important and as such, the school expects that every child will read at home at least three times a week, if your child reads five or more times a week they will receive an additional dragon wing! Reading diaries must be signed by an adult, but independent reading sessions can be filled in by your child.



Although your child may be reading independently, it is still good practice to read aloud, if you can please do take the time to listen to your child read. Reading diaries need to be handed in on Fridays, but should be in school everyday to enable volunteer readers to make entries also.

Multiplication Tables Check

In line with the National Curriculum, year 4 children are expected to know all times tables up to 12 x 12 by the end of that academic year and the government have brought in a new statutory assessment for this.

Continued support and practise of times tables at home during year 3 will be of great benefit to your child. The school subscribes to Times Table Rockstars, which is free to download onto most tablets and mobile phones. Every child has a log in which they can use at home and at school to practise their times tables.

PE

Please make sure that your child has the correct kit for PE lessons. Indoor kit should include: a white t-shirt, black shorts and black pumps with outdoor kit including a sweatshirt, a pair of jogging bottoms and a pair of trainers or shoes for separate use outside. Although we use set times for PE (**Tuesdays and Wednesdays**), please ensure that your child has their full PE kit in school every day, as there may be other times when it is needed.



All earrings must be removed for PE lessons, swimming included. If your child's ears have been recently pierced please provide them with tape or plasters to cover them up temporarily.
