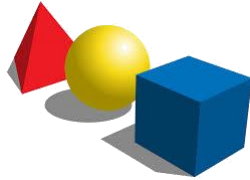
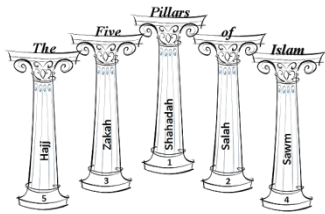


## English

We will also be using our computing skills across the rest of the curriculum.

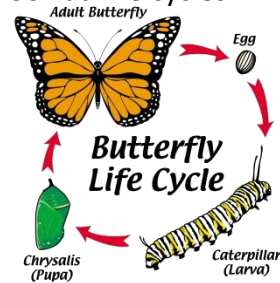


# Year 5
